## Long Term Planning Autumn Year 3 Roald Rocks



**PDL:** Settling In/ Keeping Safe in School

**RE:** Holy (Nativity KS2)

**Rationale:** To give the children an opportunity to explore Roald Dahl, his writing and his influences. To begin to read like a writer and write like a reader. To begin to study the stone age and to think about what it was like to live in this era of pre-history.

### Rocks

- Compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties
- Describe in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rock
- Recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.

### Light

- Recognise that they need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light
- Recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect their eyes
- Recognise that shadows are formed when light from a light source is blocked by a solid object. Explore patterns of shadow size
- Notice that light is reflected from surfaces – explore which surfaces reflect best.
