TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The Club only takes responsibility for children and young people in the water and on poolside. At all other times children remain the responsibility of the teachers.
2. Children and young people are to use the designated children's changing area provided.
3. Permission must be arranged with SwimClub before taking any photographic images with a camera/mobile phone or video.
4. Parents/Guardians are not allowed on poolside without permission of the school or SwimClub.
5. Please note that no outdoor shoes are worn on poolside. Shoe covers are provided.
6. **Food or drink** is not to be consumed on poolside or in the changing rooms.
7. Swim hats are to be worn by all swimmers.
8. When a pool is not available on a longer term basis (in excess of one week), on public health or other grounds outside of our control (not including operational issues with the pool), then we cannot be responsible for providing any further lessons during that time. If this occurs, and in the event that it is not possible to reschedule the classes, we will use best endeavours to either refund the unused balance of your course fees or to recompense you in services or refunds in a future cycle.
9. SwimClub is under no obligation to refund lessons that may be missed by local adverse weather when the venue and environs are safe and accessible and lessons are held. We regret that we are unable to offer automatic refunding or rescheduling of lessons in the event of adverse conditions local to yourselves preventing you from attending a scheduled class.
10. Should the child have, or develop, any known or suspected medical condition you must please consult your doctor before bringing them swimming and inform SwimClub via email or post. All information received is treated in confidence and with sensitivity.
11. Never bring a child swimming if they have any illness such as an ear infection, diarrhoea, chicken pox, impetigo, conjunctivitis or a bad cold. Please wait until the doctor has given the all-clear before returning to classes.
12. In the instance of sickness and diarrhoea the child must have been clear of all symptoms for at least 48 hours before attending a lesson.
13. SwimClub may, at its own discretion, refuse entry to a client to its courses if it is felt that the client's behaviour is unreasonable.
14. Whilst it is our policy that we endeavour to ensure you always have the same teacher, we cannot guarantee this as teachers fall ill, leave etc. Also, due to the extremely thorough nature of our training, we may occasionally need to have a new instructor teaching your class. They are always fully trained at this point but need to teach a series of 'live classes' in order to complete their assessment process. Unfortunately, we cannot give advance warning when this may happen and, whilst we always try to limit it, it is a necessary part of our commitment to quality.
