Dear Parents

Swimming begins for Year 5 pupils on Tuesday 18th September 2018 at Energique, Anstey Park. All pupils take part in this programme which is funded by the school. There will be 10 swimming sessions and instructors will be employed to teach the swimming groups. The children will be supervised on the walk there and back by their class teacher and LSA's. Swimming is part of the National Curriculum, where it states that schools must provide swimming instruction.

If your child is fit enough to be in school, we would like them to swim. If they are not fit to swim, please send a note. Children who have verrucas can swim but may wish to wear a plastic swimming sock. Children should make sure that on swimming days they have an outdoor coat, hat and gloves because we will be walking in all weathers. Please label the swimming kit, bag and swimming hat. Children will not be allowed to wear earrings in the pool, therefore they should be left at home on swimming days. **PLEASE NOTE THAT DUE TO ENERGIQUE RULES, SWIMMING CAPS ARE COMPULSORY FOR BOYS AND GIRLS REGARDLESS OF HAIR LENGTH – NO CAP, NO SWIM.**
